Stained Glass Production: From design (*vidimus*) to Cartoon and then production and the techniques used.

Brief History: Looking at examples in local churches up to Victorian Era.

The Sanctuary windows at Stisted Church: How Onley Savill-Onley filled many of these windows with continental glass from the Renaissance period, including important panels from the cloisters of Steinfeld Abbey, Germany

Restoration Distinguishing between original and later insertions/restorations

19th Century Glass Changes in style during the latter half of the 19th century, such as the influence of the Pre-Raphaelites and the Aesthetic Movement as seen in examples of stained glass and other monuments at Stisted Church.

20th Century Glass Stylistic changes during the 20th century as shown in the Frederick May Memorial window and other monuments at Stisted Church.

Makers Marks/Monograms and 'House Styles' Examples to be seen at Stisted and other local churches.
