Weald and Downland Museum

The Museum is in the South Downs National Park and has a collection of rescued rural homes and buildings set in the landscape. The site includes a 17th century working watermill and a functional Tudor kitchen along with many examples of Wealden houses, shops and workshops.

There is a cafe serving meals, teas and snacks and picnic facilities around the site. There is also a gift shop which sells local produce.
