Branch treasurer's report

Autumn Term 2021 started online with Roger Cook's 8 wk course, Parliament part 2, attended by 14 students and with a bank balance 0f £2,553.60. Also that term, Andrew Beharrell's 10 wk Zoom course, Plants, Politics and Economics, attracted 16 students. All fees were paid centrally and a Branch Credit Note for £166.40 was paid from WEA into our account by electronic transfer. We paid a donation by cheque for £12 to St Peter's Parish Magazine for advertising which was shown on an earlier statement. Our Spring Term 2022 online course, From Mandarins to Commissars with David Prynn, was attended by 25 students and a Branch Credit Note for £204.80 brought our balance to £2,924.80 at 30 March 2022.
